

INTRODUCTION TO GARDENING THE BIODYNAMIC WAY

Biodynamics is an organic method of cultivation arising out of Rudolf Steiner's Spiritual research. It was his response to questions from farmers who were unhappy with 'chemical' agriculture. Biodynamics works with the rhythms of the movements of the Sun, Moon, planets and stars, to which the plants respond.



The workshop will cover the background of the biodynamic planting calendar and using the biodynamic preparations. It's autumn so we will focus on sharing tips for harvesting, composting and preparing your garden for winter. For the last hour, we'll stir the horn manure preparation (known as 500), so bring an empty screw top bottle if you would like to take some home. A 500ml bottle is enough for an average garden. The workshop is suitable for those new to biodynamics and for anyone who would like to give their garden, window boxes or house plants an autumn treat!

Rudolf Steiner and the New Prehistory A one-day seminar with author Andrew Welburn Saturday 13 December 10.00 - 16:00



Rudolf Steiner is unrivalled for 'the big perspective' on human origins – and potential. New revolutionary scientific ideas are just catching up.

The Stone Age no longer stands for brutish cave men. Its stunning cavepaintings are now known to be visionary journeys, reflecting a clairvoyant consciousness under whose guidance ours emerged. Spirituality made us human, yet there were other humans, like the Atlanteans mentioned by Steiner. Welburn has argued persuasively that the Neanderthals — nowadays acknowledged as highly intelligent, deeply creative and lovers of music – are a humanity of that type. These stages of human origin will be richly explored in this seminar centred around Welburn's new book, "After Atlantis".

A distinguished scholar, Andrew Welburn has held fellowships from the British Academy and the Frances Yates Trust at the universities of London and Oxford. Andrew's wider interests have included spiritual and religious history, especially the deeper roots of Christianity in the evolution of humanity. His most recent books are "Neanderthals and Atlantis" (2024) and "After Atlantis" (2025).
